VIENNA ART WEEK LOSING CONTROL 12 – 19 NOVEMBER 2021

Art takes the spotlight again in Vienna from 12 to 19 November 2021: over seven days, VIENNA ART WEEK presents an outstanding artistic program featuring everything from exhibitions and performances to talks and lectures, guided tours and special programs. Around 200 events by approximately 50 collaborating program partners shift attention to the city's sprawling and diverse art scene.

House of Losing Control

The motto for this year's VIENNA ART WEEK is "Losing Control". It is a theme that invites artistic grappling with real or threatened loss of control – one that calls for new consideration given the pandemic and climate crisis. Among the highlights of this year's VIENNA ART WEEK is an opportunity to do just that: a former car dealership (complete with workshops and side buildings) in Vienna's 20th district, not far from the Augarten park, becomes the setting for an exhibition of work by 80 national and international artists. Its 40 rooms and spacious halls are home to the week-long "House of Losing Control", an over 4,300-square-meter exhibition showcasing an array of visual art, performances and music. Works on view include those by Ruth Anderwald + Leonhard Grond, Ramesch Daha, Christian Eisenberger, Gelitin, Soli Kiani, Jyoti Mistry, Bruce Nauman, Javier Téllez, and Erwin Wurm, among others.

Curated by Robert Punkenhofer, Artistic Director of VIENNA ART WEEK, the week-long exhibition opens on Saturday, 13 November 2021. "The 'House of Losing Control' was conceived as an experimental space and stage for diverse explorations of 'Losing Control', the guiding theme of this year's VIENNA ART WEEK. That said, the art week is also an occasion for celebration and contemplation – aspects more in demand than ever in times of pandemic and crisis."

Losing Control Exhibition Parcours and Open Studio Days

Held during opening weekend on Saturday, 13 November, and Sunday, 14 November, the "Losing Control Exhibition Parcours" takes visitors to ten studios showing work related to the VIENNA ART WEEK theme. Its supporting program includes a number of curator talks in the artists' workspaces. "Losing Control Exhibition Parcours" participants include Ruth Anderwald + Leonhard Grond, Crisfor, Dejan Dukic, Christian Eisenberger, Denise Rudolf Frank, Les Tardes Goldscheyder, Ernst Logar, Markus Redl, Almut Rink, and Hubert Scheibl.

That first weekend also brings open-studio presentations highlighting the work of some 100 artists. Workspaces on the "Open Studio Days" tour are spread across Vienna's 1st to 21st districts and offer an in-depth look at current art production in the city.

LOSING CONTROL Line-up

Thursday, 18 November 2021, features discussions with distinguished guests from the arts and sciences. Participants address a variety of topics related to the loss of control. Focal points include conscious letting-go, immersion in creative flow and ecstasy, but also the potential threats associated with a loss of control over one's own life. The "LOSING CONTROL Line-up" presents talks, lectures, presentations and film screenings in quick succession. Participants include the sociologist and economist Saskia Sassen (Columbia University, New York City), curator Sergio Edelsztein (Tel Aviv/Berlin), artist Javier Téllez (Venezuela), writer and philosopher Jules Evans (London Philosophy Club), as well as digital humanism scientists Jörg Flecker (University of Vienna), Hannah Metzler (Complexity Science Hub Vienna), and Martin Kampel (Vienna University of Technology).

Program partners

Museums, major art institutions and -universities, exhibition halls and selected galleries are as much a part of Vienna Art Week as artists' studios and independent art spaces. "Gallery Tours" take visitors to selected galleries. The week affords a dense program of high-caliber talks, lectures, performances and guided tours to a wide variety of art venues, with significant input from program partners.

The building becomes a living stage for an open, internationally networked art scene with a focus on emerging visual art, performance and music.

INITIATORS

Martin Böhm, President of Art Cluster Vienna, and Robert Punkenhofer, Artistic Director of VIENNA ART WEEK, founded the art festival 17 years ago and made it a fixture in the Austrian and international art calendars.

ART CLUSTER VIENNA

Art Cluster Vienna was founded in 2004 to position Vienna as a national and international hotspot of art. It is an association of leading art institutions in the city of Vienna. VIENNA ART WEEK is held by Vienna's major museums, exhibition venues, art spaces, institutions of art education, and galleries. Their ideas and high-quality programs are the backbone of the art week, which has long established itself as an annual fixture in the city's art agenda in fall since it was launched in 2004. Attracting approximately 35,000 visitors from Austria and abroad, the festival enhances Vienna's profile as an international hotspot of art.
